4. Title: Electric utilities; protection of customer data.

5. Summary: Directs the State Corporation Commission to convene and facilitate a Data Access Stakeholder group to assist development of draft regulations that (i) ensure the protection of the personally identifiable information of customers of each electric utility and (ii) provide mechanisms by which customers can access and obtain the customer's utility usage data as specified by the customer. The measure prescribes the subjects to be considered by the Stakeholder group which must convene by September 1, 2019 and conclude by April 1, 2020. The Commission is directed to then report the recommendations of the Stakeholder group to the General Assembly.
