4. Title: Salaries of executive officers at public institutions of higher education

5. Summary: The substitute legislation requires the governing board of each public institution of higher education to report, by September 1 of each year to the Chairmen of the House Committees on Appropriations and Education and the Senate Committees on Finance and Education and Health, the salary by position of any executive officer of such institution that exceeds for the previous fiscal year the salary limit for the chief executive officer for the institution set forth in the general appropriation act.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. Any cost to compile the list of executive officers that exceed the previous fiscal year salary of the chief executive officer can be absorbed by the institution.
