5.	<b>Summary:</b> Authorizes the Treasury Board to issue bonds pursuant to Article X, Section 9(c) of the Constitution of Virginia in an amount up to \$17,500,000 plus financing costs to finance a revenue-producing capital project at Radford University.  The bonds are backed by the full faith and credit of the Commonwealth and therefore constitute tax-supported debt. The bill also declares that an emergency exists and that the bil is effective upon passage.

7.	<b>Fiscal Impact Estimates:</b> Final. It is expected that this project will generate sufficient nongeneral fund revenues to pay operating expenses and debt service.
