8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation requires the review process to be completed within ten business days for applications for community or long-term care services for individuals diagnosed with a terminal condition. Making changes to the review process in order to identify and prioritize specific applications requires an update to the Virginia Case Management System (VaCMS). The estimated cost to make these updates is \$55,000; this cost includes the discovery and coding of the changes, testing the changes, and updating the production environment. It is assumed that the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) will provide federal funding for 75 percent of the one-time cost needed for the system modifications, leaving 25 percent, or \$13,750, to be funded with general fund dollars. The Department of Social Services can absorb the general fund portion of these system modifications within its current appropriation.
