**4. Title:** Medical assistance services; expediting application for individuals diagnosed w/ terminal condition

**5. Summary:** The enrolled bill requires the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) to issue an annual report regarding (i) the number of screenings for eligibility for community-based and institutional long-term care services are conducted and (ii) the number of those screenings which are not completed within 30 days. Note: The introduced HB 2474 directed DMAS to develop and implement an expedited review process for applications for community or institutional long-term care services for individuals diagnosed with a terminal condition.
