4. Title: Governor's secretaries; Secretary of Workforce Development created.

5. Summary: Creates in the Governor's cabinet the position of Secretary of Workforce Development (the Secretary). The bill removes the position of Chief Workforce Development Advisor and reassigns that position's responsibilities to the Secretary.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No fiscal impact is expected to state agencies.

8. Fiscal Implications: No fiscal impact to the state is expected as the Chief Workforce Development Advisor is currently performing similar functions to those of the Secretary of Workforce Development. The additional evaluation and reporting requirements of the Secretary and other cost are expected to be absorbed by current resources.
