2. Patron: Rush

3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Restoration of firearms rights; report to State Police.

5. Summary: Requires the courts to certify and forward to the Central Criminal Records Exchange (CCRE), on a form provided by the CCRE, a copy of a restoration order that unconditionally authorizes possessing, transporting, or carrying a firearm, ammunition for a firearm, or a stun weapon. Such form shall be accompanied by a complete set of the petitioner's fingerprints. The Department of State Police must enter the petitioner's name and description into the CCRE such that the order's existence will be made known to all law enforcement personnel accessing the computerized criminal history records on the CCRE for investigative purposes. The bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2021.
