3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Public schools; counseling services; parental rights.

5. Summary: Prohibits a student from being required to receive personal or social counseling services without written parental consent. Provides that a parent of a student may, at his sole discretion, be present at any personal or social counseling service in which his child is required to participate. The bill requires parental notification for each instance a student is required to receive personal or social counseling services, which notification shall include information about the services that are scheduled for the student, the purpose and general description of the services, ways parents may review materials to be used, and the procedures by which parents may be present or limit or prohibit the student's participation.
