3. Committee: Commerce and Labor

4. Title: Health care shared savings; incentive programs.

5. Summary: Requires health carriers to establish a comparable health care service incentive program under which savings are shared with a covered person who elects to receive a covered health care service from a lower-cost provider. Incentive payments are not required for savings of \$25 or less. Programs are required to be approved by the Commissioner of Insurance.

6. Budget amendment necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Fiscal Impact Estimates on the State Corporation Commission to carry out the provisions of House Bill 2639 are not available. See Item 8 below.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Corporation Commission recognizes that additional resources will be necessary to perform the functions of the new Comparable Health Care Service Incentive Program. A preliminary review indicates that the Commission could absorb the cost of these additional resources.

9. Specific agency or political subdivisions affected: State Corporation Commission Bureau of Insurance

10. Technical amendment necessary: No

11. Other comments: The State Commission Bureau of Insurance provided technical assistance to the patron and interested parties on the provisions of the bill. Senate Bill 1611 is identical to House Bill 2639.
