3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Condominium Act; meetings of unit owners' associations; proxy voting.

5. Summary: Provides that any proxy shall be void if not signed by the unit owner or, in cases where the unit owner is more than one person, by all such unit owners. The bill provides that in cases where the unit owner is more than one person, any such unit owner may object to the proxy at or prior to the meeting, whereupon the proxy shall be deemed revoked. Under current law, the proxy of any person is void if not signed by a person having authority, at the time of the execution thereof, to execute deeds on behalf of that person.
