4. Title: Membership on the Virginia Foundation for the Humanities task force

5. Summary: The legislation adds five members to the task force established to assist the Virginia Foundation for the Humanities in its work regarding the history of formerly enslaved African Americans in Virginia.

The additional members are the executive director of the Virginia Tourism Authority or his designee, the chairman of the board of trustees of the Virginia Outdoors Foundation or his designee, and three nonlegislative citizen members appointed by the Governor, at least one of whom is required to be the president of a historically black college or university located in the Commonwealth.

8. Fiscal Implications: The legislation does not state how many meetings will be needed to carry out the duties of the task force. However, members are eligible to receive compensation for the performance of their duties as provided in §2.2-2813, Code of Virginia. All members shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in §§2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825, Code of Virginia. These additional citizens members will be compensated from any appropriation provided to the Foundation.
