4. Title: Advance estimate of patient payment amount for elective medical procedure, test, or service.

5. Summary: Requires medical care facilities licensed by the Board of Health to provide an estimate to the patient or his representative of the payment amount for which the patient will be responsible for elective medical procedures, tests, or services at least three days in advance of the scheduled elective medical procedure, test, or service. Current law requires hospitals to disclose such estimate if requested by a patient or patient's representative at least three days in advance.
