- 3. Committee: Health, Wealth and Institutions
- **4.** Title: Child day programs; licensure exemption.
- **5. Summary:** Exempts from licensure any child day program in which child-minding services are offered on site by a business to no more than four children under the age of 13 at any given time, provided that the parent or guardian of every child is an on-duty employee of the business and can resume responsibility for the child's supervision within 30 minutes upon request.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation adds child-minding services offered on-site by a business to no more than four children at a time under the age of 13 to the list of child day program not required to be licensed. It is unknown how many of these programs currently operate in Virginia; however, these programs are exempt from licensure, except if the Commissioner of Social Services receives a complaint about the program. It is assumed that current licensing staff could handle any inspections arising from complaints. This bill does not have a fiscal impact.
