4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; tuition and fee increases; public comment.

5. Summary: Requires the governing board of each public institution of higher education, prior to a vote on an increase in undergraduate tuition or mandatory fees, to permit public comment on the proposed increase at a meeting of the governing board. The bill requires each such governing board to establish policies for such public comment, which may include reasonable time limitations.

8. Fiscal Implications: No state fiscal impact is anticipated. There may be small costs to institutions associated with public meetings or otherwise facilitating public comment.
