3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: School boards; local law-enforcement agencies, memorandums of understanding.

5. Summary: Requires the school board in each school division in which the local law-enforcement agency employs school resource officers to enter into a memorandum of understanding with such local law-enforcement agency that sets forth the powers and duties of the school resource officers. The bill requires each such school board and local law-enforcement agency to review and amend or affirm the memorandum at least once every five years.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this legislation will not have a state fiscal impact.
