**3. Committee:** Education and Health

**4. Title:** School safety procedures; emergency situations; annual training.

**5. Summary:** Requires each public elementary and secondary school principal to develop and deliver to each student and employee in the school at least once annually training on safety procedures in the event of an emergency situation on school property. Designates the Board of Education to develop guidelines for the development and delivery of training required by this act.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Any costs to localities in implementing the requirements of this legislation are indeterminate at this time. It is anticipated that the Board of Education and Department of Education can absorb such costs related to the development and delivery of training required by this act.
