2. Patron: Hanger

3. Committee: Rehabilitation and Social Services

4. Title: Licensed family day homes; storage of firearms.

5. Summary: Requires that firearms and ammunition in a licensed family day home be stored in a locked closet, cabinet, or container during the family day home's hours of operation. The bill requires that the key or combination to such locked storage places be maintained out of the reach of all children in the family day home.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill does not have a fiscal impact. Current licensed family day home regulations require firearms and ammunition to be locked and secured separately from one another and for the key or combination to be inaccessible to children. The substitute removes the allowance for firearms to be lawfully carried on an individual's person in the family day home during the home's hours of operation.
