4.	<b>Title:</b> Major information technology project procurement; terms and conditions, etc.
5.	<b>Summary:</b> Requires in any contract for a major information technology project, terms and conditions relating to the indemnification obligations and liability of a contractor to be reasonable and to not exceed in aggregate twice the value of the contract. The bill also provides that there shall be no limitation on the liability of a contractor for (i) any intentiona or willful misconduct, fraud, or recklessness of a supplier or any employee of a supplier or (ii) claims for bodily injury, including death, and damage to real property or tangible personal property resulting from the negligence of a supplier or any employee of a supplier.

- **8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact is indeterminate due to the varied nature of the IT contracts managed by VITA. There are no additional costs from a staffing perspective anticipated from this legislation. However, limiting the liability of a contractor to a maximum of twice the value of a contract may increase the financial risk for the Commonwealth, should one of the information technology contracts that VITA manages have an applicable breach.
