3. Committee: Passed Both Houses.

4. Title: Motor fuels.

5. Summary: Requires every dispensing device used in the retail sale of motor fuel to identify the motor fuel and be labeled in accordance with a publication of the National Institute of Standards and Technology. The measure authorizes the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services to amend or reject such identification or labeling requirements. Existing provisions regarding the labeling of motor fuel dispensing devices are removed.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The bill will align Virginia's requirements related to the method of sale of motor fuels with new technologies and new motor fuel products offered for sale in Virginia.
