4. Title: Juveniles tried as an adult

5. Summary: The substitute bill requires the attorney for the Commonwealth to give written notice of his intent to try a juvenile in circuit court for a violation of Code of Virginia, §16.1-269.1, subsection C. Prior to giving written notice, the attorney for the Commonwealth must submit a written request to the director of the court services unit to complete a report as described in of Code of Virginia, §16.1-269.2, unless waived by the juvenile and his attorney or other legal representative. The bill requires the report to be filed with the court and mailed or delivered to the attorney for the Commonwealth;, counsel for the juvenile, or, if the juvenile is not represented by counsel, to the juvenile and a parent, guardian or other person standing in loco parentis with respect to the juvenile, within 21 days of the date of the written request.
