4.	Title:	Motor vehicle safety inspections; cost evaluation by DMV and the Department of State Police.						
5.	Summary: Provides that the Department of Motor Vehicles and the Department of State Police shall jointly evaluate the feasibility of including in a motor vehicle safety inspection the inspection of: (i) window tint to ensure that tinting is within the legal range established in the Virginia Code, and (ii) noise levels of exhaust systems to ensure that such noise levels are in compliance with the Code. The bill requires that such evaluation include the estimate cost of an inspection that includes these components, and the amount by which the charges currently set in the Code would increase. The Department of Motor Vehicles and the Department of State Police shall complete their evaluation by November 30, 2019 and submit an executive summary and report of such findings and recommendations to the General Assembly for publication as a House or Senate document. The bill requires that such executive summary and report shall be submitted no later than December 1, 2019 and posted to the General Assembly's website.
