3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Standards of Learning Innovation Committee; conflicts of interest; repeal.

5. Summary: Provides that in addition to any conflict of interest prohibited by the State and Local Government Conflict of Interests Act, no person shall serve as a nonlegislative citizen member or as the chair of the Standards of Learning Innovation Committee if he has a personal interest in a contract with a school board. Under current law, the State and Local Government Conflict of Interests Act prohibits a person from serving on the Committee if he has a personal interest in a contract or other conflict of interest with the Board of Education. The bill repeals the Standards of Learning Innovation Committee effective January 1, 2020.
