**4. Title:** Traffic impact analysis; solid waste management facilities.

**5. Summary:** Requires a locality to submit to the Department of Transportation a traffic impact analysis for any proposed rezoning application for a new solid waste management facility.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), conducting a transportation impact analysis can cost between \$500 to \$10,000, depending upon complexity. Generally there are not large numbers of landfill actions in the state in any single given year. Assuming one landfill is built or expanded via an action that involves a rezoning, the cost to VDOT can be expected to be under \$10,000.
