3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Restoration of certain highways; payment of costs.

5. Summary: Clarifies that the Department State Police and/or a local law enforcement agency, in conjunction with other public safety agencies, may restore a highway to its condition prior to a motor vehicle accident or incident. It provides that the owner and carrier of any vehicle, cargo, or personal property removed or disposed of such a highway is responsible for paying all costs billed for such removal, and reimbursing costs incurred by various transportation and public safety agencies, or individuals or entities acting on the agencies' behalf. It adds individuals or entities acting at the request of the Department of State Police or any local law enforcement agency to the list of entities that are entitled to reimbursement under this section.
