10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 22.1-204.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-204.1. Firearm safety education program. Local school boards may shall provide firearm safety education programs for students in the
13 14	elementary school all grades. To assist local school boards electing to provide firearm safety education
15	programs, the The Board of Education shall, in consultation with the Department of State Police,
16	establish curriculum guidelines for a standardized program of firearm safety education for the elementary
17	school grades to promote the protection and safety of children students enrolled in the public schools.
18	The curriculum guidelines shall incorporate, among other principles of firearm safety, accident
19	prevention and the rules upon which the Eddie Eagle Gunsafe Program offered by the National Rifle
20	Association is based. Local school boards electing to provide firearm safety education shall offer a
21	minimum of two hours of instruction pursuant to that is consistent with the Board's curriculum guidelines
22	and shall integrate firearm safety education into appropriate subject areas, if feasible, to ensure that
23	every elementary grade student completes the course of study in firearm safety education any family life
24	education program offered by the school board. For any grade or school division for which a family life
25	education program is not offered, such instruction shall be integrated into other subject areas or
26 27	provided as a separate program. Such firearm safety education program shall be taught by a school resource officer, other law enforcement officer or a United States Armed Forces instructor. No firearms
27 28	resource officer, other law-enforcement officer, or a United States Armed Forces instructor. No firearms shall be used in such firearm safety education program.
