Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. § 1. That the Department for Aging and Rehabilitative Services shall make information regarding vocational rehabilitation programs and employment services available to assist former law-enforcement officers who have a disability as a result of their service with preparing for, obtaining, and maintaining suitable employment, including information on the types of programs available and the process by which former law-enforcement officers who have a disability as a result of their service in the commonwealth.

14 § 2. That every law-enforcement agency in the Commonwealth shall provide to every law-enforcement 15 officer who separates from the agency due to a disability resulting from his service information 16 regarding vocational rehabilitation programs and employment services available to assist former

17 law-enforcement officers who have a disability as a result of their service with preparing for, obtaining,18 and maintaining suitable employment, including information on the types of programs available and the

19 process by which such law-enforcement officers may access such programs and services.
