A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 22.1-135.2, relating to public schools; potable water.

Patrons—Hayes, Jenkins and Samirah; Senator: Spruill

Referred to Committee on Education

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-135.2 as follows: § 22.1-135.2. Potable water.
- A. The Board of Education shall not approve the plans and specifications for a new school building, an addition to a school building, or an alteration of a school building estimated to cost \$50,000 or more contemplated by a local school board unless the plans and specifications provide for the following:
 - 1. A minimum of two water bottle filling stations in each school;
- 2. A minimum of one drinking fountain or water bottle filling station on each floor and wing of each school building; and
- 3. A minimum of one drinking fountain or water bottle filling station for every 100 students projected to attend the school upon completion of the proposed construction.
- B. Any water bottle filling station installed in a public school shall dispense filtered, clean drinking water; be regularly cleaned and maintained; and, if there is no drinking fountain on the same floor and wing as the water bottle filling station, be accompanied by a cup dispenser.
- C. Any drinking fountain installed in a public school shall be equipped with a protective cowl; be equipped with a water spout at least one inch above the overflow rim of the drinking fountain; dispense filtered, clean drinking water; and be regularly cleaned and maintained.
- D. The Board of Education shall amend its regulations to require local school divisions to allow all students to carry and utilize a water bottle while at school.
