That § 2.2-2400 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 2.2-2400. Art and Architectural Review Board; members and officers; travel expenses; 11 12 quorum; compensation; staff; report. 13 A. The Art and Architectural Review Board (the Board) is established as an advisory board, within 14 the meaning of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government. The Board shall consist of six 15 seven voting members as follows: the Director of the Department of Historic Resources, or his designee, 16 serving as an ex officio member and five six citizen members, appointed by the Governor. Of the citizen members, one shall be an architect who may be appointed from a list of two or more architects 17 nominated by the governing board of the Virginia Society of the American Institute of Architects; one 18 19 may be appointed from a list of two or more persons nominated by the governing board of the University of Virginia; one shall be a member of the board of trustees of the Virginia Museum of Fine 20 21 Arts; and two three shall be appointed from the Commonwealth at large, one of whom shall be a painter 22 or sculptor. Lists of nominees shall be submitted at least 60 days before the expiration of the member's 23 term for which the nominations are being made in order to be considered by the Governor in making 24 appointments pursuant to this section. 25 B. [Beginning July 1, 2011, the Governor's appointments of the five six citizen members shall be 26 staggered as follows: two members for a term of one year, two members for a term of two years, and 27 one member two members for a term of three years. Thereafter, Following the initial staggering of terms, citizen] members of the Board shall be appointed for terms of four years each, except 28 29 appointments to fill vacancies, which shall be for the unexpired terms. No member shall serve for more 30 than two consecutive four-year terms, except that any member appointed to the unexpired term of 31 another shall be eligible to serve two consecutive four-year terms. Vacancies shall be filled in the manner of the original appointments. The Director of the Department of Historic Resources shall serve a 32 33 term coincident with his term of office. 34 C. Annually, the Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman and may elect such other officers as 35 the Board deems proper from among its membership. A majority of the members of the Board shall 36 constitute a quorum. 37 D. The members of the Board shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for all 38 reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties as provided in § 2.2-2825. 39 E. The Division of Engineering and Buildings of the Department of General Services shall provide 40 assistance to the Board in the undertaking of its responsibilities. F. The Board shall submit a biennial report to the Governor and General Assembly on or before 41 42 October 1 of each even-numbered year. [2. That the term of the citizen member added to the Art and Architectural Review Board 43

44 pursuant to this act shall be for a term of four years, to begin July 1, 2020.

3. That the terms of the citizen members of the Art and Architectural Review Board that are set
to begin July 1, 2022, shall be staggered as follows: two members for a term of one year; one
member for a term of two years; and two members for terms of three years. Thereafter, members
shall serve terms of four years.]
