2 *An Act to amend and reenact § 24.2-622 of the Code of Virginia, relating to sample ballots; color of*  
3 *paper of unofficial sample ballots.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 24.2-622 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 **§ 24.2-622. Unofficial sample ballots.**

9 Nothing contained in this title shall be construed to prohibit: (i) the printing and circulation of  
10 sample paper ballots, which are not printed on white or yellow paper and do include thereon the words  
11 "sample ballot" in type no smaller than 24 point; (ii) the printing and circulation of sample voting  
12 equipment ballots, provided such sample ballots include on their face the words "sample ballot"; or (iii)  
13 the Sample ballots not authorized by electoral boards and provided by electoral boards or general  
14 registrars to precincts pursuant to § 24.2-641 are permitted to be printed and circulated, which includes  
15 publication in newspapers or on the Internet of sample ballots of either type.

16 Sample ballots, in whole or in part, other than the official sample ballots, Such sample ballots shall  
17 not be printed on white or yellow paper and shall include on their face the words "sample ballot" in a  
18 font size no smaller than 24 point.

19 All sample ballots, excepting those official sample ballots authorized by electoral boards and  
20 provided by electoral boards or general registrars to precincts pursuant to § 24.2-641, are  
21 advertisements for purposes of Chapter 9.5 (§ 24.2-955 et seq.). Voters may take sample ballots into the  
22 voting booth or enclosure, but shall not give, tender, or exhibit such sample ballot to any person, other  
23 than an assistant designated under § 24.2-649, while inside the polling place or within the prohibited  
24 area designated by § 24.2-604.
