| 11 | § 9.1-906.1. Emergency shelters; notification; registration; penalty. |
| 12 | A. Any person required to register or reregister who enters any place or facility that is designated by |
| 13 | the Commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof as an emergency shelter and operated in |
| 14 | response to a state or local emergency declared pursuant to Chapter 3.2 (§ 44-146.13 et seq.) of Title |
| 15 | 44 shall, as soon as practicable after entry, notify a member of the emergency shelter's staff who is |
| 16 | responsible for providing security at the emergency shelter that such person is a registered sex offender. |
| 17 | Any person who violates this subsection is guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor. |
| 18 | B. Upon being notified by such person that he is a registered sex offender, the emergency shelter's |
| 19 | staff may access the Registry information regarding such person that is publicly available on the |
