10 11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-371.01 as follows:
12	§ 18.2-371.01. Causing or encouraging acts rendering children sexually abused; penalty.
13	Any person 18 years of age or older who (i) (a) has physical custody of a minor, (b) allows a minor
14	to reside at his residence, (c) is in a position of trust or authority over a minor, or (d) is the temporary
15	caretaker of a minor; (ii) is more than three years older than such minor; and (iii) willfully contributes
16	to, encourages, or causes any act, omission, or condition that results in any sexual act upon the minor
17	in violation of the law is guilty of a Class 4 felony.
18	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
19	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the
20	necessary appropriation cannot be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult
21	correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 854 of the Acts of Assembly of 2019 requires the Virginia
22	Criminal Sentencing Commission to assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to

23 § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0 for 24 periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
