6	A BILL to require the Board of Medicine to annually communicate to relevant practitioners the
7	importance of screening patients for prenatal and postnatal depression and other depression.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The Board of Medicine shall annually issue a communication to every practitioner licensed by
10	the Board who provides primary, maternity, obstetrical, or gynecological health care services reiterating
11	the standard of care pertaining to prenatal or postnatal depression or other depression. Such
12	communication shall encourage practitioners to screen every patient who is pregnant or who has been
13	pregnant within the previous five years for prenatal or postnatal depression or other depression, as
14	clinically appropriate and shall provide information to practitioners regarding the factors that may
15	increase susceptibility of certain patients to prenatal or postnatal depression or other depression,
16	including racial and economic disparities, and encourage providers to remain cognizant of the increased

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risk of depression for such patients.
