| 9 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 10 | 1. That § 22.1-79.7 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 11 | § 22.1-79.7. School meal policies. |
| 12 | Each local school board shall adopt policies that: |
| 13 | 1. Prohibit school board employees from requiring a student who cannot pay for a meal at school or |
| 14 | who owes a school meal debt to throw away or discard a meal after it has been served to him, do |
| 15 | chores or other work to pay for such meals, or wear a wristband or hand stamp; and |
| 16 | 2. Require school board employees to direct any communication relating to a school meal debt to the |
| 17 | student's parent. Such policy may permit such communication to be made by a letter addressed to the |
| 18 | parent to be sent home with the student. |
