6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 22.1-135.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 **§ 22.1-135.1. Potable water; lead testing.**

9 Each local school board shall develop and implement a plan to test and, if necessary, remediate  
10 potable water from sources identified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as high priority for  
11 testing, including bubbler-style and cooler-style drinking fountains, cafeteria or kitchen taps, classroom  
12 combination sinks and drinking fountains, and sinks known to be or visibly used for consumption. *Such*  
13 *plan shall be consistent with guidance published by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency or the*  
14 *Department of Health.* The local school board shall give priority in the testing plan to schools whose  
15 school building was constructed, in whole or in part, before 1986. *Each local school board shall submit*  
16 *such testing plan and report the results of any such test to the Department of Health. Each local school*  
17 *board shall take all steps necessary to notify parents if testing results indicate lead contamination that*  
18 *exceeds 10 parts per billion.*
