14	Any locality may by ordinance prohibit the distribution, sale, and offer for sale of disposable plastic
15	shopping bags to consumers. No prohibition adopted under the authority of this section shall apply to
16	plastic bags that are (i) specifically designed and manufactured for multiple reuse, exhibiting durable
17	construction, a thickness of at least 2.25 mils, and a pair of handles; (ii) used to carry alcoholic
