A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 40.1-29.1, relating to disclosure of terms of employment.

Referred to Committee on Commerce and Labor

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 40.1-29.1 as follows: § 40.1-29.1. Disclosure of terms of employment.
 - A. Every employer shall, at the time of the employee's hiring, furnish to each employee:
 - 1. A written disclosure that shows:
 - a. The name of the employee;
- b. The name of the employer, in addition to any trade name or assumed name under which the employer conducts business in the Commonwealth;
 - c. The street address and phone number of the employer's main office or principal location;
- d. The rate of pay and basis thereof, whether paid by the hour, shift, day, week, salary, piece, commission, or other basis, including overtime rate of pay;
- e. For employees paid a piece rate, the applicable piece rate of pay and the number of pieces completed at each piece rate; and
 - f. The regular payday established by the employer as required by subdivision A 1 of § 40.1-29; and
- 2. A physical or digital copy of the driver's license or government-issued identification card of (i) the employer, if the employer is an individual, or (ii) the employee's immediate supervisor, if the employer is not an individual.
- B. Every employer shall notify its employees in writing of any changes to the information set forth in subsection A at least seven calendar days prior to the time of such changes.
