6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-135.1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to local school boards;
7	lead testing; report; parental notification.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 22.1-135.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 22.1-135.1. Potable water; lead testing.
11	Each local school board shall develop and implement a plan to test and, if necessary, remediate
12	potable water from sources identified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as high priority for
13	testing, including bubbler-style and cooler-style drinking fountains, cafeteria or kitchen taps, classroom
14	combination sinks and drinking fountains, and sinks known to be or visibly used for consumption. Such
15	plan shall be consistent with the guidance published by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency or
16	the Department of Health. The local school board shall give priority in the testing plan to schools whose
17	school building was constructed, in whole or in part, before 1986. Each local school board shall submit
18	such testing plan and report the results of any such test to the Department of Health. Each local school
19	board shall take all steps necessary to notify parents if testing results indicate lead contamination that
