9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

10 1. That § 18.2-365 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

11 § 18.2-365. Adultery defined; civil penalty.

12 Any person, being married, who voluntarily shall have has sexual intercourse with any person not his 13 or her spouse shall be is guilty of adultery, punishable as a Class 4 misdemeanor and is subject to a 14 civil penalty of not more than \$250, which shall be payable to the Literary Fund. Any law-enforcement

**15** officer may issue a summons for a violation of this section.
