6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 24.2-525 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 24.2-525. Persons entitled to have name printed on ballot.**

9 A. Only a person meeting all the qualifications and fulfilling all the requirements of a candidate, and
10 who has complied with the rules and regulations of his party, shall have his name printed on the ballot
11 provided for the primary election. *A person who does not file either or both written statements required*
12 *by § 24.2-503 by the relevant deadline, or the end of the extension period if an extension has been*
13 *granted pursuant to that section, shall not have his name printed on the ballot provided for the primary*
14 *election.*

15 B. No person shall have his name printed on the ballot for more than one office at any one primary
16 election. However, a candidate for federal or statewide office, or a candidate for an office being filled in
17 a special election, may have his name printed on the ballot for two offices at a primary election.
