- 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 7 1. That § 2.2-3901 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 2.2-3901. Unlawful discriminatory practice, gender discrimination, and racial discrimination 9 defined.

A. Conduct that violates any Virginia or federal statute or regulation governing discrimination on the
 basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions,
 age, marital status, or disability shall be an "unlawful discriminatory practice" for the purposes of this
 chapter.

B. The terms "because of sex or gender" or "on the basis of sex or gender" or terms of similar
import when used in reference to discrimination in the Code and acts of the General Assembly include
because of or on the basis of pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions. Women affected by
pregnancy, childbirth or related medical conditions shall be treated the same for all purposes as persons
not so affected but similar in their abilities or disabilities.

19 C. The terms "because of race" or "on the basis of race" or terms of similar import when used in

20 reference to discrimination in the Code and acts of the General Assembly include because of or on the

21 basis of traits historically associated with race, including hair texture, hair type, and protective
22 hairstyles such as braids, locks, and twists.
