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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 55.1-1823.1, 55.1-1962.1, and 3 55.1-2139.1 relating to common interest communities; electric vehicle charging stations permitted.

6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 55.1-1823.1, 55.1-1962.1, 8 and 55.1-2139.1 as follows: 9

§ 55.1-1823.1. Electric vehicle charging stations permitted.

10 A. Except to the extent that the declaration or other recorded governing document provides otherwise, no association shall prohibit any lot owner from installing an electric vehicle charging 11 12 station for the lot owner's personal use on property owned by the lot owner. An association may 13 establish reasonable restrictions concerning the number, size, place, and manner of placement or 14 installation of such electric vehicle charging station on the exterior of property owned by the lot owner.

15 B. An association may prohibit or restrict the installation of electric vehicle charging stations on the 16 common area within the development served by the association and may establish reasonable 17 restrictions as to the number, size, place, and manner of placement or installation of electric vehicle 18 charging stations on the common area.

19 \vec{C} . Any lot owner installing an electric vehicle charging station shall indemnify and hold the 20 association harmless from all liability, including reasonable attorney fees incurred by the association 21 resulting from a claim, arising out of the installation, maintenance, operation, or use of such electric 22 charging station. An association may require the lot owner to obtain and maintain insurance covering 23 claims and defenses of claims related to the installation, maintenance, operation, or use of the electric 24 vehicle charging station and require the association to be included as a named insured on such policy. 25

§ 55.1-1962.1. Electric vehicle charging stations permitted.

26 A. Except to the extent that the condominium instruments provide otherwise, no unit owners' 27 association shall prohibit any unit owner from installing an electric vehicle charging station for the unit 28 owner's personal use within the boundaries of a unit or limited common element parking space 29 appurtenant to the unit owned by the unit owner.

30 B. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or the condominium instruments, the unit 31 owners' association may prohibit a unit owner from installing an electric vehicle charging station if 32 installation of the electric vehicle charging station is not technically feasible or reasonably practicable 33 due to safety risks, structural issues, or engineering conditions.

34 C. The unit owners' association may require as a condition of approving installation of an electric 35 vehicle charging station that the unit owner:

36 1. Provide detailed plans and drawings for installation of an electric vehicle charging station 37 prepared by a licensed and registered electrical contractor or engineer familiar with the installation and 38 core requirements of an electric vehicle charging station. 39

2. Comply with applicable building codes or recognized safety standards.

40 3. Comply with reasonable architectural standards adopted by the unit owners' association that 41 govern the dimensions, placement, or external appearance of the electric vehicle charging station.

42 4. Pay the costs of installation, maintenance, operation, and use of the electric vehicle charging 43 station.

44 5. Indemnify and hold the unit owners' association harmless from any claim made by a contractor or 45 supplier pursuant to Title 43.

46 6. Pay the cost of removal of the electric vehicle charging station and restoration of the area if the 47 unit owner decides there is no longer a need for the electric vehicle charging station.

48 7. Separately meter, at the unit owner's sole expense, the utilities associated with such electric 49 vehicle charging station and pay the cost of electricity and other associated utilities.

50 8. Engage the services of a licensed electrician or engineer familiar with the installation and core 51 requirements of an electric vehicle charging station to install the electric vehicle charging station.

52 9. Obtain and maintain insurance covering claims and defenses of claims related to the installation, 53 maintenance, operation, and use of the electric vehicle charging station and provide a certificate of 54 insurance naming the unit owners' association as an additional insured on the unit owner's insurance 55 policy for any claim related to the installation, maintenance, operation, or use of the electric vehicle 56 charging station within 14 days after receiving the unit owners' association's approval to install such

charging station. 57

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58 10. Reimburse the unit owners' association for any increase in common expenses specifically 59 attributable to the electric vehicle charging station installation, including the actual cost of any 60 increased insurance premium amount, within 14 days' notice from the unit owners' association.

61 D. The conditions imposed pursuant to this section on unit owners for installation of an electric 62 vehicle charging station shall run with title to the unit to which the limited common element parking 63 space is appurtenant.

64 E. Any unit owner installing an electric vehicle charging station in a unit or on a limited common 65 element parking space appurtenant to the unit owned by the unit owner shall indemnify and hold the 66 unit owners' association harmless from all liability, including reasonable attorney fees incurred by the 67 association resulting from a claim, arising out of the installation, maintenance, operation, or use of such electric charging station. A unit owners' association may require the unit owner to obtain and maintain 68 69 insurance covering claims and defenses of claims related to the installation, maintenance, operation, or 70 use of the electric vehicle charging station and require the unit owners' association to be included as a 71 named insured on such policy. 72

§ 55.1-2139.1. Electric vehicle charging stations permitted.

73 A. Except to the extent that the declaration provides otherwise, no association shall prohibit any 74 proprietary lessee from installing an electric vehicle charging station for the proprietary lessee's 75 personal use within the boundaries of a unit or limited common element parking space appurtenant to 76 the unit owned by the proprietary lessee.

77 B. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or the declaration, the association may 78 prohibit a proprietary lessee from installing an electric vehicle charging station if installation of the 79 electric vehicle charging station is not technically feasible or practicable due to safety risks, structural 80 issues, or engineering conditions.

C. The association may require as a condition of approving installation of an electric vehicle 81 82 charging state that the proprietary lessee:

83 1. Provide detailed plans and drawings for installation of an electric vehicle charging station 84 prepared by a licensed and registered electrical contractor or engineer familiar with the installation and 85 core requirements of an electric vehicle charging station.

2. Comply with applicable building codes or recognized safety standards.

3. Comply with reasonable architectural standards adopted by the association that govern the 87 88 dimensions, placement, or external appearance of the electric vehicle charging station.

89 4. Pay the costs of installation, maintenance, operation, and use of the electric vehicle charging 90 station.

91 5. Indemnify and hold the association harmless from any claim made by a contractor or supplier 92 pursuant to Title 43.

93 6. Pay the cost of removal of the electric vehicle charging station if the proprietary lessee decides 94 there is no longer a need for the electric vehicle charging station.

95 7. Separately meter, at the proprietary lessee's sole expense, the utilities associated with such electric 96 vehicle charging station and pay the cost of electricity and other associated utilities.

8. Engage the services of a licensed electrician or engineer familiar with the installation and core 97 98 requirements of an electric vehicle charging station to install the electric vehicle charging station.

99 9. Obtain and maintain insurance covering claims and defenses of claims related to the installation, 100 maintenance, operation, and use of the electric vehicle charging station and provide a certificate of insurance naming the association as an additional insured on the proprietary lessee's insurance policy 101 102 for any claim related to the installation, maintenance, operation, or use of the electric vehicle charging 103 station within 14 days after receiving the association's approval to install such charging station.

104 10. Reimburse the association for any increase in common expenses specifically attributable to the 105 electric vehicle charging station installation, including the actual cost of any increased insurance premium amount, within 14 days' notice from the association. 106

107 D. The conditions imposed pursuant to this section on proprietary lessee for installation of an 108 electric vehicle charging station shall run with title to the unit to which the limited common element 109 parking space is appurtenant.

110 E. Any proprietary lessee installing an electric vehicle charging station in a unit or on a limited common element parking space appurtenant to the unit owned by the proprietary lessee shall indemnify 111 112 and hold the association harmless from all liability, including reasonable attorney fees incurred by the 113 association resulting from a claim, arising out of the installation, maintenance, operation, or use of such 114 electric charging station. An association may require the proprietary lessee to obtain and maintain 115 insurance covering claims and defenses of claims related to the installation, maintenance, operation, or 116 use of the electric vehicle charging station and require the association to be included as a named 117 insured on such policy.
