That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 30 a chapter numbered 60, consisting 12 of sections numbered 30-376 through 30-382, as follows: 13 14 CHAPTER 60. COMMISSION ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION AND MODERNIZATION. 15 16 § 30-376. Commission on School Construction and Modernization; purpose. The Commission on School Construction and Modernization (the Commission) is established in the 17 legislative branch of state government. The purpose of the Commission is to develop and provide 18 guidance and resources to local school divisions related to school construction and modernization and 19 20 make funding recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly. 21 § 30-377. Membership: terms. The Commission shall have a total membership of 15 members that shall consist of eight legislative 22 23 members, three nonlegislative citizen members, and four ex officio members. Members shall be 24 appointed as follows: three members of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; 25 five members of the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates in 26 accordance with the principles of proportional representation contained in the Rules of the House of Delegates; one nonlegislative citizen member to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; one 27 28 nonlegislative citizen member to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; and one 29 nonlegislative citizen member to be appointed by the Governor. The Superintendent of Public 30 Instruction, the Director of the Department of General Services, the Executive Director of the Virginia 31 Resources Authority, and the Director of the Department of Planning of Budget, or their respective designees, shall each serve ex officio with voting privileges. Nonlegislative citizen members of the Commission shall be citizens of the Commonwealth. Unless otherwise approved in writing by the 32 33 34 chairman of the Commission and the respective Clerk, nonlegislative citizen members shall only be 35 reimbursed for travel originating and ending within the Commonwealth for the purpose of attending 36 meetings. 37 Legislative members and ex officio members of the Commission shall serve terms coincident with 38 their terms of office. Appointments to fill vacancies, other than by expiration of a term, shall be for the 39 unexpired terms. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. All 40 members may be reappointed. Nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for a term of two 41 vears. 42 The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership, who shall be 43 members of the General Assembly. 44 § 30-378. Quorum; meetings; voting on recommendations. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum. The meetings of the Commission shall be held 45 46 at the call of the chairman or whenever the majority of the members so request. No recommendation of the Commission shall be adopted if a majority of the Senate members or a 47 48 majority of the House members appointed to the Commission (i) vote against the recommendation and 49 (ii) vote for the recommendation to fail notwithstanding the majority vote of the Commission. 50 § 30-379. Compensation; expenses. 51 Legislative members of the Commission shall receive such compensation as provided in § 30-19.12. 52 and nonlegislative citizen members shall receive such compensation for the performance of their duties 53 as provided in § 2.2-2813. All members shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. Compensation to 54 55 members of the General Assembly for attendance at official meetings of the Commission shall be paid by the offices of the Clerk of the House of Delegates or Clerk of the Senate, as applicable. All other compensation and expenses shall be paid from existing appropriations to the Commission or, if 56 57 58 unfunded, shall be approved by the Joint Rules Committee.

59 § 30-380. Powers and duties of the Commission.

60 The Commission shall have the following powers and duties:

61 1. Assessing the Commonwealth's school facilities and determining school construction and 62 modernization funding needs.

63 2. Identifying funding mechanisms and making recommendations to the Governor and the General 64 Assembly.

3. Establishing best practices in school modernization and construction for school divisions.

66 4. Creating standardized construction designs and procurement practices to recommend and make 67 available to local school divisions.

68 5. Identifying potential cost-saving measures for implementation by local school divisions to minimize 69 construction and modernization costs where possible.

70 6. Submitting to the General Assembly and the Governor an annual report for publication as a report document as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports. The chairman of the Commission shall submit to the 71 72 General Assembly and the Governor an annual executive summary of the interim activity and work of 73 74 the Commission no later than the first day of each regular session of the General Assembly. The executive summary shall be submitted for publication as a report document as provided in the 75 76 procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents 77 and reports and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website.

78 § 30-381. Staffing.

79 Administrative staff support shall be provided by the Office of the Clerk of the Senate or the Office 80 of the Clerk of the House of Delegates as may be appropriate for the house in which the chairman of the Commission serves. The Division of Legislative Services shall provide legal, research, policy 81 82 analysis, and other services as requested by the Commission.

83 § 30-382. Sunset.

This chapter shall expire on July 1, 2026.

2. That, for its first year of existence, if the Commission is not funded by a separate appropriation 85

in the appropriation act, the Commission may be funded from the operating budgets of the Clerk 86

87 of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Delegates upon the approval of the Joint Rules

88 Committee. If the Commission is not funded by a separate appropriation in the appropriation act

89 for any year thereafter, this chapter shall expire on July 1 of the fiscal year in which the 90

Commission fails to receive such funding.
