SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 129

3 Commending the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot. 4

WHEREAS, the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2019; and

6 7 WHEREAS, in 1919, members of the congregation at the First Baptist Church in Williamsburg formed their own church, the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot; and 8

9 WHEREAS, initially only a few members in a one-room building owned by W.T. Brown, the Zion 10 Baptist Church of Lightfoot congregation grew under the leadership of the Reverend L.W. Wales, eventually prompting the need for a full-time pastor; and 11

WHEREAS, the Reverend E.D. McCray served the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot congregation 12 13 from 1920 to 1925, followed by the Reverend F.E. Segar, who led the church for 42 years until he retired in 1967; meanwhile, Sister Gladys Stone served as church clerk from 1920 to 1947; and 14

15 WHEREAS, the next minister to lead the congregation, the Reverend Llovd Williams, Sr., contributed greatly to the church's progress; during his tenure from 1968 to 1991, membership in the 16 Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot increased, new auxiliaries were created, and services such as Sunday 17 School Worship and Wednesday night Bible Study fostered deeper engagement with the church; and 18

19 WHEREAS, the growth of the church demanded a new sanctuary, and construction of the current 20 Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot began in 1970; continuing on this forward path, the church built an 21 additional building in the 2010s to further expand its sanctuary; and

WHEREAS, in recent years, the congregation has been well-served by the wisdom and guidance of 22 23 the Reverend Carlton B. Johnson, the Reverend Horace Suber, and the current pastor, the Reverend 24 Valerie Matthews; and

25 WHEREAS, the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot has been an integral part of many lives and a 26 beacon for the community the past 100 years; now, therefore, be it

27 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring. That the General Assembly hereby 28 commend the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot on the occasion of its 100th anniversary of service; and, 29 be it

30 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 31 presentation to the Reverend Valerie Matthews, pastor of the Zion Baptist Church of Lightfoot, as an expression of the General Assembly's deep admiration for the church's history and best wishes for the 32 33 future.
