3	Requesting the Department of Environmental Quality to study revised priority ranking criteria for grants
4	from the Stormwater Local Assistance Fund to include reduction of nitrogen pollution. Report.

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9	WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Quality administers the Stormwater Local Assistance
10	Fund (the Fund), which provides matching grants to localities to invest in stormwater best management
11	practices to reduce pollutants, specifically phosphorus, as runoff to local waterways; and
12	WHEREAS, the Fund is critical to meeting the goals in the Commonwealth's Phase III Watershed
13	Implementation Plan for the Chesapeake Bay Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL); and
14	WHEREAS, projects that receive grants from the Fund are primarily for stream restoration, wet
15	ponds, bioretention, and constructed wetlands and typically cost less than \$50,000 per pound of
16	phosphorus removed; and
17	WHEREAS, grants from the Fund are prioritized based on the greatest expected water quality benefit
18	in terms of phosphorus, but not nitrogen or any other pollutant; and
19	WHEREAS, approximately 60 percent of awarded Fund dollars since fiscal year 2014 have gone
20	toward stream restoration, a practice that is effective at reducing phosphorus; and
21	WHEREAS, for developed lands, the Commonwealth has achieved 88 percent of its required
22	phosphorus reduction but only 40 percent of its required nitrogen reduction, according to the
23	Commonwealth's Phase III Watershed Implementation Plan; and
24	WHEREAS, for the Chesapeake Bay TMDL, the Commonwealth is overachieving its phosphorus
25	reduction goals and underachieving its nitrogen reduction goals; now, therefore, be it
26 27	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Department of
27 28	Environmental Quality (the Department) be requested to study revised priority ranking criteria for grants from the Stormwater Local Assistance Fund to include reduction of nitrogen pollution.
20 29	In conducting its study, the Department shall (i) analyze the benefits and costs of nitrogen pollution
3 0	reduction in Virginia's waters and compare to the benefits and costs of reductions in phosphorous
31	pollution, and (ii) determine comparable criteria to award grants from the Fund based on nitrogen
32	reductions and revise the Fund's award criteria accordingly.
33	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Department for this study, upon
34	request.
35	The Department shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2020, and shall submit to the
36	Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report of its findings and
37	recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive summary and report
38	shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for
39	the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the 2021 Regular
40	Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's website [; and, be it
41	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the provisions of this joint resolution shall not become effective
42	unless an appropriation effectuating the purposes of this joint resolution is included in a general
43	appropriation act passed in 2020 by the General Assembly that becomes law].
