**3. Committee:** Health, Welfare and Institutions

**4. Title:** Certified registered nurse anesthetists; prescriptive authority.

**5. Summary:** Authorizes certified registered nurse anesthetists to prescribe Schedule II through Schedule VI controlled substances and devices, provided such prescribing is in accordance with requirements for practice by certified registered nurse anesthetists.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. No Fiscal Impact.**

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Board of Nursing would need to receive applications from certified registered nurse anesthetists who want to add prescriptive authority to their license. The cost of processing such applications would be offset by the current application fee, therefore this would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth.
