3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Elections; campaign finance; committee depositories and reimbursement.

5. Summary: Clarifies that committee treasurers may pay expenses by electronic debit drawn on a designated committee depository. Current law only allows for a check drawn on such depository. The bill also clarifies that reimbursements may be made for electronic debit payments made by an authorized committee representative. The bill contains technical amendments.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.
