3. Committee: Passed both houses

4. Title: Parental educational information; tobacco and nicotine vapor products.

5. Summary: Requires each school board to annually provide parents of pupils in grades kindergarten through 12 information regarding the health dangers of tobacco and nicotine vapor products. The bill requires that the information provided be consistent with guidelines set forth by the Department of Education.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: Yes, Item 137.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: To establish the guidelines for information regarding the health dangers of tobacco and nicotine vapor products, the Department of Education (DOE) estimates an additional one-time cost of \$9,000 in FY 2021. DOE would need to convene committees of subject-matter experts and specialists who teach and/or create prevention resources for adult learners. DOE anticipates two committee meetings with an estimated cost of \$5,000. Additionally, DOE anticipates the need for wage support to assist with drafting these guidelines. DOE estimates a cost of \$4,000 to support this wage position. Any fiscal impact to local school divisions is indeterminate.
