4. Title: Stormwater Mgmt. Fund; grants from local Fund may be used for an authorized local credit option.

5. Summary: Provides that grants from a local Stormwater Management Fund may be used for an authorized local stormwater credit option for Virginia Stormwater Management Program authorized program administrators as a stormwater retrofit for any development within the local watershed that predates the 2005 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Department of Environmental Quality best management practice criteria. Currently, the grants may only be used for (i) the construction, improvement, or repair of a stormwater management facility or (ii) erosion and sediment control.
