3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; in-state tuition; refugees.

5. Summary: Provides that an individual is eligible for in-state tuition charges regardless of domicile if he is admitted to the United States as a refugee under 8 U.S.C. § 1157 or has a Special Immigrant Visa that has been granted a status under P.L. 110-181 § 1244, P.L. 109-163 § 1059, or P.L. 111-8 § 602, and upon entering the United States, the individual resided in the Commonwealth and continues to reside in the Commonwealth.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill could allow for certain students to become eligible for in-state tuition who currently pay the out-of-state rate, and would constitute a loss of revenue equal to the difference between the two for institutions where such students are enrolled. The number of students who would be affected is indeterminate.
