Summary: Requires each school board to establish a process for assisting any student whose family members have one or more medical conditions that preclude them from providing transportation for the student to attend school to apply for and obtain a pass to ride a regionally operated or locally operated bus to school.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no immediate state fiscal impact under Direct Aid to Public Education. In outgoing years, there could be an increase in the prevailing pupil transportation costs funded through basic aid to account for any increased local cost for regionally operated or locally operated buses; however, any actual impact is indeterminate at this time. Any fiscal impact to local school divisions is indeterminate.
